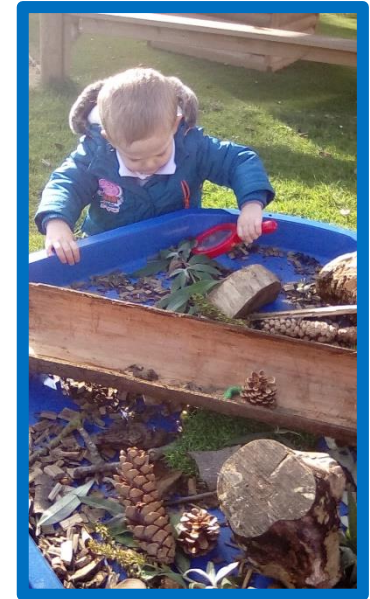

## What can I expect?

The two-year old class will be led and managed by an experienced, qualified teacher who promotes a love of learning through exploration and investigation. ## When can I apply for two year old funding?

### If your child is two between:

- 1 September and 31 December – Apply between October and December, eligible from January (spring term)
- 1 January and 31 March – Apply between January and March eligible from April (summer term)
- 1 April and 31 August – Apply between mid-May and August eligible from September (autumn term)





## Am I entitled to free childcare for my 2 year old?

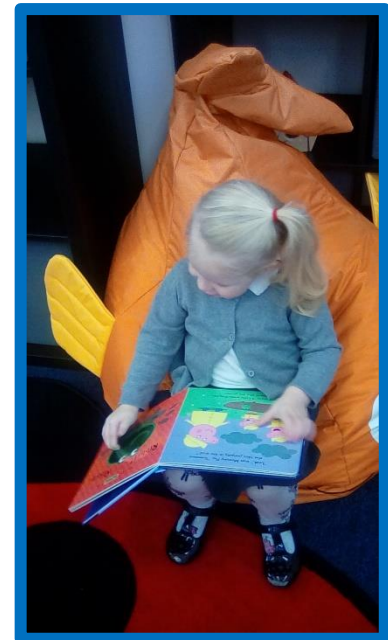

Your 2-year-old can get free childcare if you live in England and get one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Universal Credit, and your household income is £15,400 a year or less after tax, not including benefit payments
- tax credits, and your household income is £16,190 a year or less before tax
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- the Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

2-year-olds can also get free childcare if they:

- are looked after by a local authority
- have a statement of special education needs (SEN) or an education, health and care (EHC) plan
- get Disability Living Allowance
- have left care under an adoption order, special guardianship order or a child arrangements order





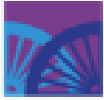

## Privately funded childcare

### Fees

8.30am – 11.30am = £13.
